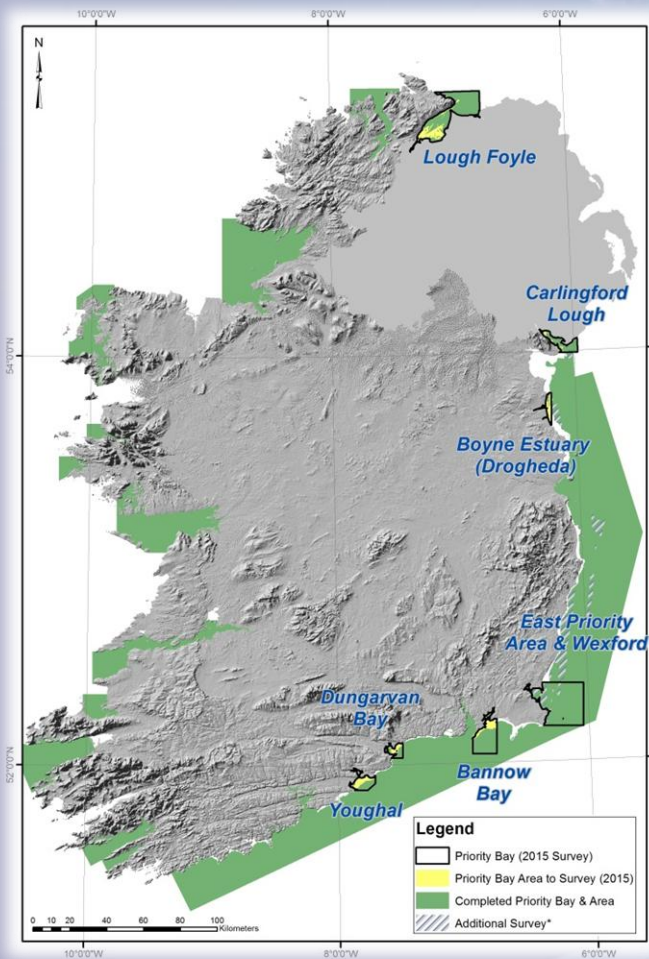


SURVEY OPERATIONS 2015

INFOMAR – Integrated Mapping for the Sustainable Development of Ireland’s Marine Resources

Between March and October 2015, INFOMAR, the national seabed mapping programme, will be engaging in routine hydrographic survey* activities in Carlingford Lough, Boyne Estuary, Bannow Bay, Dungarvan, Youghal, Lough Foyle and Wexford**. These surveys will be carried out using high frequency multibeam echo-sounders and all data acquired will underpin improvements to future navigation charts and environmental assessments, and will be freely and publicly available.
